EXM 3.0 Update 1 to EXM 3.0 Update 2

Instrcuctions for updating from EXM 3.0 Upd-1 to EXM 3.0 Upd-2



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Introduction

This document describes the EXM update process that lets you update your EXM installation from EXM 3.0 Update-1 to EXM 3.0 Update-2.

You can save the list of potential problems in an XML file and review them later. When the automatic update process is finished, you need to perform the post installation steps described in this manual. Ensure that these steps are performed before rebuilding the Experience database (xDB), which is part of Sitecore XP upgrade process.

Note

We recommend that you back up all Sitecore databases and the Sitecore instance before starting the update process, because this update is a non-reversible procedure.

Using the EXM Update Package

Prerequisities

Prerequisites for running the EXM update package:

- Disable the Sitecore. EmailCampaign.config file by adding .disabled to the file extension.
- Disable all scheduled tasks at the following locations:
 - o /sitecore/system/Tasks/Schedules/Email Campaign
 - o /sitecore/system/Modules/E-mail Campaign Manager/Tasks
- Upgrade Sitecore to Sitecore XP 8.0 Update-2.

Accessing the Update Process

To access the EXM update process, enter the following URL in your browser:

http://<your_host_name>/sitecore/admin/UpdateInstallationWizard.aspx

If prompted, enter your credentials to access the Sitecore instance.

Note

Before running the Update Package, you must ensure that there are no message dispatches in the Processing or Paused state.

Update Process

Install Update Package

The update package includes new items required for EXM 3.o. To download the EXM update package, visit the EXM 3.0 Module Upgrade page on the dev.sitecore.net.

Click **Install update package** to start the update package installation.

Analyzing the Update Package

Click **Analyze** to perform an analysis of the installation process to identify potential problems that can occur during the installation. The update tool does not make any changes to the Sitecore instance during this action.


The tool displays the progress bar and the number of processed actions.


You can review the analysis information messages or download them as a file by clicking the **Download as File** link.

We strongly recommend to review the analysis messages before continuing the installation.

There are several types of messages: errors, collisions, warnings and information messages. Each message type is marked with a colored square:

- lead for errors.
- blue for collisions.
- yellow for warnings.
- grey for information messages.


Errors, collisions and warnings are considered as potential problems and you should pay attention to them.

At the top of the page, you can see the information bar. The color of the information bar indicates the importance of problems that were found during the analysis.

At the bottom of the page, you can see overall statistics and a link that allows you to download all the messages in the grid as an XML file. When you are ready to install the package, click **Install the package**.


Installing the Package

Post Installation Steps

After installing the update package, you should perform the following post installation step:

• Copy the EmailCampaign.config configuration file from the EXM 3.0 Update-2 package to the instance.

Your custom settings are not ported to the new configuration file automatically. If you used any custom settings in the previous version and you want to apply them to EXM 3.0 Update-2 as well, make needed changes to the EmailCampaign.config file manually.
